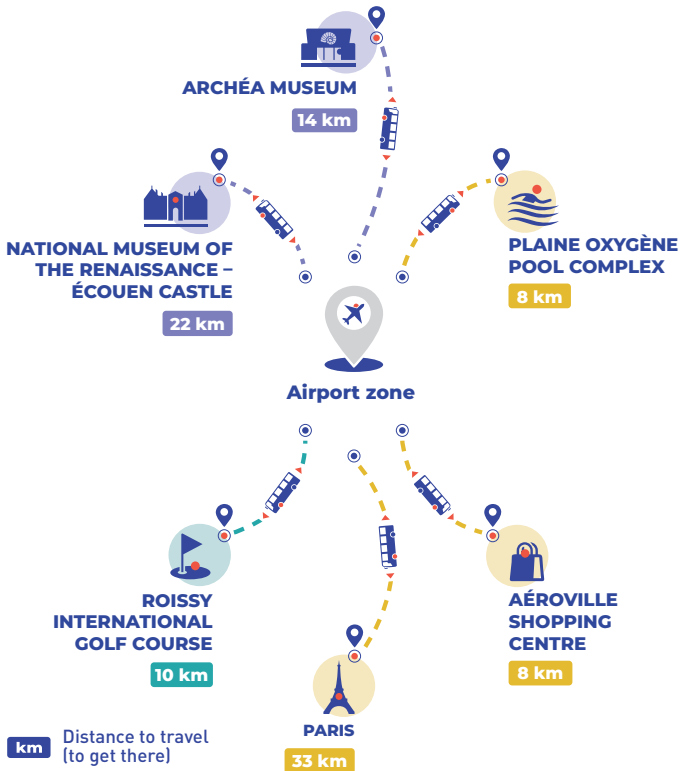


## DISCOVER THE GRAND ROISSY STOPOVER **CITY TOUR**

The Grand Roissy Tourist Office has 6 circuits that give you the opportunity to discover a selection of gems in the area from 4 July to 31 August 2022.



## USEFUL INFORMATION

### ► Can you take your suitcases on the bus?

You can only take one piece of hand luggage and one piece of cabin-sized luggage. You can leave your luggage at the "Bagages du Monde" left luggage service in Terminal 2E, TGV-RER station (opposite the Sheraton hotel).

### ► Who can go on a City Tour?

Anyone can go on a Grand Roissy Stopover City Tour: adults, senior citizens, young people, children and infants, people with reduced mobility. An adult must supervise children under 18 at all times.

### ► What about getting to the plane?

The bus operator takes the necessary measures to respect the times given. However it is passengers' responsibility to check they have enough time to do the excursions, including the travel time. No plane ticket may be changed or refunded.

► **City Tour fares (except Paris): €5 / person**

Free for under 18 years old

► **Paris fare: €40 / person** (under 12 years old: €20 / person)

One person can book a maximum of 5 places.

- ▶ Attractive prices, with free entry or discounts negotiated with our partners.



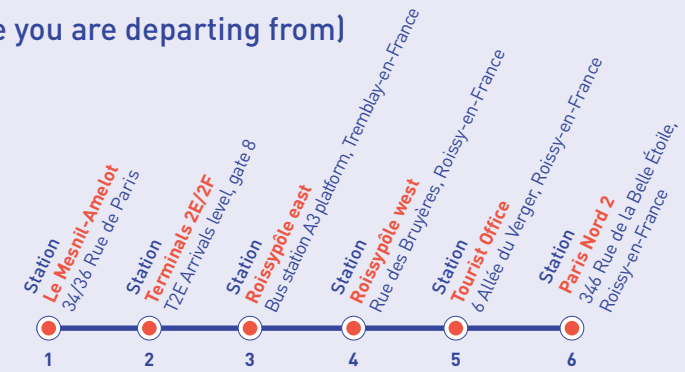
## Choose your bus station (according to where you are departing from)

GRAND ROISSY STOPOVERS buses serve 6 bus stations: choose the nearest bus station shown opposite and look up the days and times of the City Tour you want to do.

### How to you get to bus station 2 (terminal 2E/2F)

From Terminal 2: 2A/2C: go to the T2E Arrivals level, gate 8 // 2B/2D: go to the T2F Arrivals level, gate 8 // 2G: take the bus line to the T2F Arrivals level, gate 8.

From Terminal 3: Go to T2, take the CDGVal, then go to the T2F Arrivals level, gate 8.

Set in lush green nature: an 18-hole golf course, driving range, club house with terrace and restaurant, and more than 6 km of paths open to all.

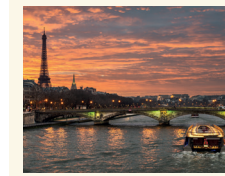
